How to treat a snakebite...

Snakes usually come out during the morning hours to hunt for food. During the peak levels of the heat, snakes look for cool areas, such as brush and rocky boulder areas, under the porch, and woodpiles.

If bitten by a snake:
immediately call 9-1-1
keep calm
remove watches, rings, shoes, etc., which may constrict swelling
firmly wrap the bite area
keep the bite area lower than victim's heart
transport safely to the nearest medical facility

Avoid first-aid treatments such as tourniquets, ice packs or cutting and sucking the poison out. These are potentially harmful.

It is also important to try to identify the snake which allows you to describe the snake to emergency personnel.
